
To: All Civil Engineering Firms

RE: REGISTRATION WITH THE BCCEI IS MANDATORY.

This circular is to remind all contractors, both main contractors and subcontractors and/or SMME's actively tendering and procuring tenders for work and /or performing work of a civil engineering nature, as defined in the registered scope of the Bargaining Council for The Civil Engineering Industry (BCCEI), of their obligation to register with same in terms of Part III of the Registration and Administration Expenses of Collective Agreement, and to submit and remit proof of payment of levy contributions as required in terms of Part II of the same agreement. The said agreement extends to both parties and non-parties operating in the civil engineering industry.

Please be advised that it is always in the best interest of the industry that everyone is compliant (including but not limited to the Main Contractors and Subcontractors), and to comply with all the collective agreements of the industry, including the aforementioned, thus failure and / or refusal to comply with the same, may compel the BCCEI to pursue enforcement processes in terms of Section 33A of The Labour Relations Act 66 of 1995 as amended.
